## Groundbreaking Study Reveals the Nonprofit Arts and Culture Sector Generated \$18M in 2022

The Pitt County Arts Council at Emerge, the Greenville-Pitt County Convention & Visitors Bureau, the Greenville Eastern North Carolina Alliance, and Pitt County Economic Development collectively announced that Pitt County's nonprofit arts and culture industry generated \$18,037,461 in economic activity in 2022, according to the newly released Arts & Economic Prosperity 6 (AEP6), an economic and social impact study conducted by Americans for the Arts.

Nationally, the AEP6 study reveals that America's nonprofit arts and culture sector is a \$151.7 billion industry—one that supports 2.6 million jobs and generates \$29.1 billion in government revenue. What continues to set AEP6 apart from other national studies is exactly why it is so useful. It is local. Pitt County has a custom economic analysis of its arts and culture sector — and the results are impressive!

**Arts and culture build stronger communities.** Every day, more than 100,000 nonprofit arts and culture organizations in the U.S. are making their communities better places to live and work by beautifying cities, fueling creativity, celebrating diversity, and bringing joy to residents. They also employ people locally, purchase goods and services from nearby businesses, and produce the authentic cultural experiences that are magnets for visitors, tourists, and new residents.
